Following is a Notice of Intention to do certain work as described below at the New Mexico State "B" Lease  
Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company Well No. 1 in 0 (Unit)

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Captioned well was drilled to a total depth of 3050' with 5 1/2" Casing set at 3004'. No gas or oil was encountered.

We propose to plug and abandon this well as follows: Fill annulus with heavy mud. Place cement plug in open hole section up into 5 1/2" Casing. Place 10 sacks cement plug in and above separation point in 5 1/2" Casing. Place cement plug from a point 25' below surface casing, extending 25' up into said casing. Place a 5 sack plug in top of surface casing, anchoring permanent marker with Section, Township, and Range stenciled thereon. Fill pits and clean up location.
