Gentlemen:

As the Garland A. Smith Honolulu State Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 20, Township 12 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Caprock-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, has been abandoned since 1958 and we have been unable to contact your principal, Mr. Garland A. Smith, we hereby make demand upon your company to plug the above-described well in accordance with a Commission-approved plugging program.

Mr. Joe D. Ramey, Supervisor, District No. 1, Oil Conservation Commission, Hobbs, New Mexico, must be contacted for an appropriate plugging program and given an opportunity to witness the plugging of the well as it is being accomplished.

If this office or Mr. Ramey has not been contacted on or before October 1, 1963, and appropriate arrangements made to plug the well, the Commission will docket a case concerning the matter.
