DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

191' T.D. Red Bed. Finished drilling 12-1/4" hole @ 1:15 PM, 1-6-55. Ran 6 jts of 8-5/8" OD casing set @ 186' and cemented with 100 sacks cement. Plug down to 175' @ 11:30 PM, 1-6-55. Maximum pump pressure - 200#. Cement circulated estimated 5 sacks. After W.O.C. for 12 hours - tested 8-5/8" OD casing with 900# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 175' to 186' and washed from 186' to 191' and tested 8-5/8" OD casing with 900# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop.  
Started drilling 7-7/8" hole @ 5:30 PM on 1-7-55.
