DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State AK #1 was drilled to a total depth of 8697' in lime. This well was tested with three drill stem tests and logged by Schlumberger. No evidence of commercial production was discovered.

This well was plugged as follows: loaded hole with heavy mud; spotted 75 sacks cement in open hole from 8444' to 8697'; spotted 50 sacks 3530' to 3690' (8 5/8" Csg. set at 3648'), 8 sacks (26') in top of 8 5/8" Csg. No attempt was made to pull 8 5/8" or 13 3/8" Csg. The pits and cellar have been filled, location leveled and cleaned up, and a 4" pipe marker cemented in top of hole and left extending 4' above surface and plugged on top.

Bill Johnson, Tool Pusher for Makin Drilling Company, Box 131, Hobbs, New Mexico; and R. M. Keger, Production Engineer, Cities Service Oil Company, Box 97, Hobbs, New Mexico were in charge of the work. Plugging was completed 7-23-53. Verbal approval received.
