## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

State AK #1 was drilled to a total depth of 8697' in lime. This well was tested with three drill stem tests and logged by Schlumberger. No evidence of commercial production was discovered.

It is proposed to plug and abandon this well by loading the hole with heavy mud; spot 75 sacks cement in open hole from approximately 8444 to 8697'; spot 50 sacks from approximately 3530 to 3690' (8 5/8" casing set at 3648'); and spot 8 sacks in top of 8 5/8" casing. No attempt will be made to pull 8 5/8" or 13 3/8" casing. It is proposed to fill cellar and pits, location to be leveled and cleaned up and abandoned with a 4" pipe marker cemented in top of hole and left extending 4' above surface and plugged on top.
