FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Intend to plug well about May 7, with 15 sacks of cement on bottom, T. D. 3034, 3047 R.F. C.I.
5 1/2" casing at 3003 1/2', fill casing with heavy mud to about 500' from surface and then start shooting off pipe.

Expect to recover about 400' of 5 1/2" casing.

Will then spot 15 sacks of cement above casing left in well and fill hole up to 50' of surface with mud and finish with cement to cellar.

Will cement piece of 4" pipe at least 4' above mean ground level for exact marker of location
