DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Squeezed 30 sacks of mud, 250 sacks of cement through perforations at 1380'. Obtained circulation of mud out of bradenhead.

Temperature survey showed cement top at 220'.

Drilled out cement to 1400' and tested by bailing 8-2, 1944.

Test showed casing still leaking.
