DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set bridging plug at 1880' and dumped 40' of Calseal. Tested bridge with hole full of oil at 1000# pressure.

Gun perforated 5½ casing with 2-½" holes at 1380' Squeezed with 150 sacks of cement. No circulation out of bradenhead obtained.

Temperature bomb went to 1245' indicating no cement behind pipe.

Drilled cement out of pipe to 1290' and tested.

Oil level rose in hole-perforations leaking. Will squeeze again.
