Following is a Notice of Intention to do certain work as described below at the Malco St. "A" Lease.

Graridge Corporation  
(Company or Operator) Well No. 2 in G (Unit)  
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 31, T. 12S, R. 32E, NMPM, Caprock Queen Pool  
(40-acre Subdivision)  
Lease County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

- I. This was an old air injection well during 1951 and 1952. It has been temporarily abandoned since then. The air injection seriously corroded the tubing and when we attempted to pull the tubing in November 1957 several hundred feet fell to bottom and plugged the hole. We were unable to clean out the well below 2790 feet.
- II. We now propose to run tubing and cement retainer to 2700' and attempt to squeeze cement into the pay sand. Then pressure up on the 5 1/2" casing to check for leaks. If none are found fill the hole with mud for permanent abandonment.
- III. There is a producing well in this same 40 acre tract.
- IV. Mr. Fisher of the Hobbs office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission is to be notified before beginning the plugging operations so that he may be present.
