FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

- This is on a manifest form (C-102) for the original one dated (12-10-57).
- This was an old air injection well during 1951 and 1952. It has been temporarily abandoned since that time. The air injection has seriously corroded the tubing. When the attempt was recently made to pull the tubing, several inches fell to bottom and jammed the hole. We were unable to clean out the fish below 27'0".
- We now propose to run tubing and cement retainer to 27'0" and attempt to squeeze cement into the old sand. Then pressure up on the 5 1/2" casing to check for leaks. If we are found still the hole with mud for permanent abandonment.
- A new producing well is now being drilled in this same unit.
- Dr. Fisher of the Hobbs office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission is to be notified before beginning the plugging operations so that he may be present.
