

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3057' Drilled well 3042' to 3057'. Ran Lane Wells Electric Survey. Ran 1' pea gravel on bottom 3057' to 3056'. Larkin Torpedo Company ran 40 qts SNG in 2 - 4' x 8' tin shells with 24 hour AQDA Bomb & Green Cave Catcher from 3056' to 3035'. Tamped with pea gravel 3035' to 3026' and 12 sacks Calseal from 3026' to 2944'. Loaded hole with 64 barrels oil. Shot detonated 10:55 A.M. 11-23-49. Gleaned hole to T.D. (3057'). Started well to pumping 12-2-49. Pumped 18 hours, 36 barrels oil, no water. 12-3-49 Pumped 24 hours, 23 barrels oil, no water. 12-4-49 Pumped 24 hours, 11 barrels oil, no water.
