Lane Pennsylvanian was perforated at 9802-9810'. A Baker Production Packer was set at 9756' for separation. A string of 2" Tubing was run and set in the Baker Production Packer to produce the Lane-Pennsylvanian Zone. A second string of tubing was suspended to a depth of 9591' to produce the Wolfcamp Zone, 9647' to 9660'.

Both zones were swabbed in.
