This well was spudded May 27, 1956. A 17 1/4" hole was drilled to 355' and 13-3/8" OD 48# H-40 new casing was cemented at 352' using 375 sacks 1:1 Pennix-Incor cement with 2% CaCl added. Cement was circulated to the surface. Cement was allowed to set 36 hours before resuming operations. The casing and cement job was tested with 600 psi for 30 minutes and found to be ok.
