FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The following operations will be performed in plugging the State of New Mexico "D" No. 1 well:

1. Place 100 sacks of cement from 12,040' to 11,680' in 7-7/8" hole.
2. Place 50 sacks cement from 9458' to 9278' in 7-7/8" hole.
3. Place 50 sacks cement from 9172' to 8992' in 7-7/8" hole.
4. Place 50 sacks cement from 3787' to 3619' in 8-5/8" casing.
5. Place 25 sacks cement from 84' to surface in 8-5/8" casing.

The space between cement plugs will be filled with 9.6# per gal. drilling mud. Cementing operations will be done by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company. Plugging of the well will begin on February 23, 1957.
