DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3815' - Total Depth - Line. Ran Temperature Survey - Top of cement on outside of 8-5/8" casing at 764', ratio of actual to calculated fill 66.6%. Checked top of cement at 3755' and tested casing with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3755' to 3815' and tested casing with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 7-7/8" hole at 5:30 P.M., 7-27-51.
