## Gentlemen:

Amerada Hess is the owner and operator of the State BTC Well No. 1, a temporarily abandoned Siluro-Devonian Well located in Unit N, Section 35-TllS-R33E, Lea County, New Mexico. We propose to cement squeeze the old producing perforations from 10,674' to 10,979', deepen from 10,980' to 11,180' and dispose of about 15,000 barrels per day at low pressure into the Lower Devonian open hole section. Source of the water is other Siluro-Devonian and Pennsylvanian Wells in the Bagley Field.
