DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3830' - Total Depth - Line. Run Temperature Survey - Top of cement on outside of 8-5/8" casing at 591', ratio of actual to calculated fill 72%. Checked top of cement at 3740'. Tested casing & connections with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3740' to 3830' & tested casing & connections with 1000# for 1/4 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 7-7/8" hole at 10:45 A.M., 12-28-50.
