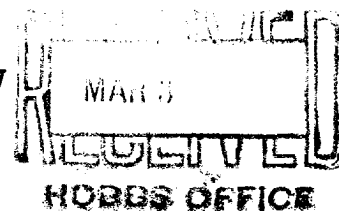

Ran 3,883' of 9 5/8" Casing, set at 3897'. Cemented with 2,600 sacks 3% Gel Cement and 200 sacks neat cement. Drilled plug March 2, 1950 and tested before and after drilling plug with 1000# pump pressure for 45 Minutes. Test showed complete shut-off
