DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5 1/2" casing was cemented at total depth 11,034' with 3000 sax. The plug was drilled out to 11,033' and a Baker bridging plug was set at 11,026' with cement on top of the plug to 11,025'. On 8/9/50 casing was tested with 1000 PSI for 30 minutes and tested O.K.
