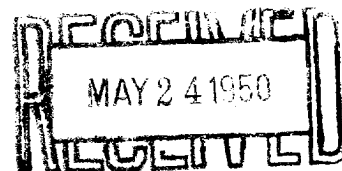

A combination string of 23#, 26#, and 29#, 7" O.D. Casing was set at 10,778 feet and cemented with 1100 sax. Plug was down at 12:05 AM, on 5-19-50. Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 6220 feet. Test for casing shut-off will be made on 5-22-50.
