The pressure information you requested on the Bagley Upper Penn. and Lower Penn. Gas Zones is listed below. These data are supplied in conjunction with Amerada's application for dual completion of the J. T. Caudle No. 2, located in NW NW Section 3 - T12S - R33E, Lea County, New Mexico.


UPPER PENN. GAS ZONE - DATUM - 4445'

Initial pressure recorded in this zone was 2475 PSI on May 8, 1951, in Amerada's W. E. Mathers No. 2, SE SE Section 3 - T-12S-R33E. Initial pressure at the same datum in Caudle No. 2 on May 7, 1960, was 1473 PSI.

LOWER PENN. GAS ZONE - DATUM - 5500'

Initial pressure in this zone was 3604 PSI recorded in October, 1951, in the Shell-Amerada State "A" Unit No. 1, SE SE Section 33-T11S-R33E. Current and initial pressure in the Caudle No. 2 on May 7, 1960, was 2243 PSI.
