3870' - Total Depth - Line. Ran Temperature Survey - Top of cement on outside of 8-5/8" casing at 427', ratio of actual to calculated fill 88.9%. Checked top of cement at 3826'. Tested casing & connections with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3826' to 3870' & tested casing & connections with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 7-3/4" hole at 3:00 P.M., 2-5-51.
