In reference to the letter written December 16, 1955, by Mr. R. Montgomery, O.C.C. Geologist, Hobbs, New Mexico, referring to Texas Pacific's State "C" A/c-2, well #1, located in the NE/4, NE/4 of Section 4, T12S, R33E, as to the accumulation of reservoir data by Texas Pacific Coal & Oil Company for the Oil Conservation Commission.

Since December 6, 1955, the forementioned well has been producing a 47.5° A.P.I. gravity oil from perforations at 9875-9889'. However, due to the inconsistency of the volume of oil being produced, also, the necessity of an intermitter to maintain production, test are being continued to evaluate producing ability, and if agreeable with the O.C.C., the accumulation of reservoir data will be deferred until optimum flowing conditions are obtained.
