9892' of 5½" - 17# N80, 17# J-55 & 15.5# J55, Seamless casing was set at 9986' with 300 sacks of Inferno Sl-Set Cement. Plug was pumped down at 1:45 A.M., November 11, 1955. The 5½" casing was pressured up with 1000# and held for 30 minutes. Pipe test was O.K.

By a temperature survey taken November 11, 1955, the top of the cement was found to be at 7675'.
