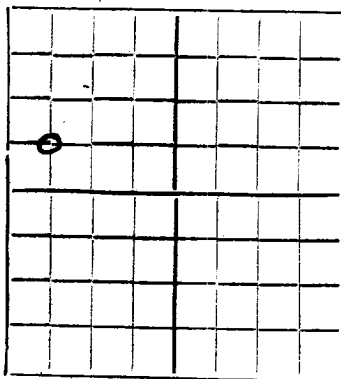

LOCATE WELL CORRECTLY

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Rotary to top salt; cable tools to bottom unless excessive gas requires use of rotary to drill section below top salt.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Necessary affidavits showing ownership of lands in New Mexico by two sureties are being prepared in accordance with instructions from the Commissioner and will be filed within the next week.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3950 feet.

 (c) 8-5/8" string to be set in top of line - cemented or mudded according to elevation of line.
