Detailed plans to plug and abandon this well, a newly completed dry hole, were discussed with Mr. R. S. Blynn, Engineer, in the Hobbs, N. M. office.

Fifty feet cement plugs were to be placed above 9800 feet in open hole and above 3300 feet in the lower part of the intermediate casing. No casing was to be removed. The hole was to be filled to the surface with heavy drilling mud and a cap screw was to be installed in the top of the 9 5/8" O.D. casing in the cellar. Plugging date April 19, 1950.
