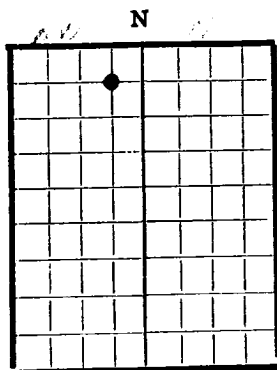

Additional information: When originally drilled this well was called Vickers Petroleum Co. No. 1 Continental-Barnes. It has 13 3/8" Surface Pipe set at 250' cemented to the surface. Well was plugged & abandoned at a T.D. of 5316'. Present plans are to deepen this well to approximately 10,000 feet.

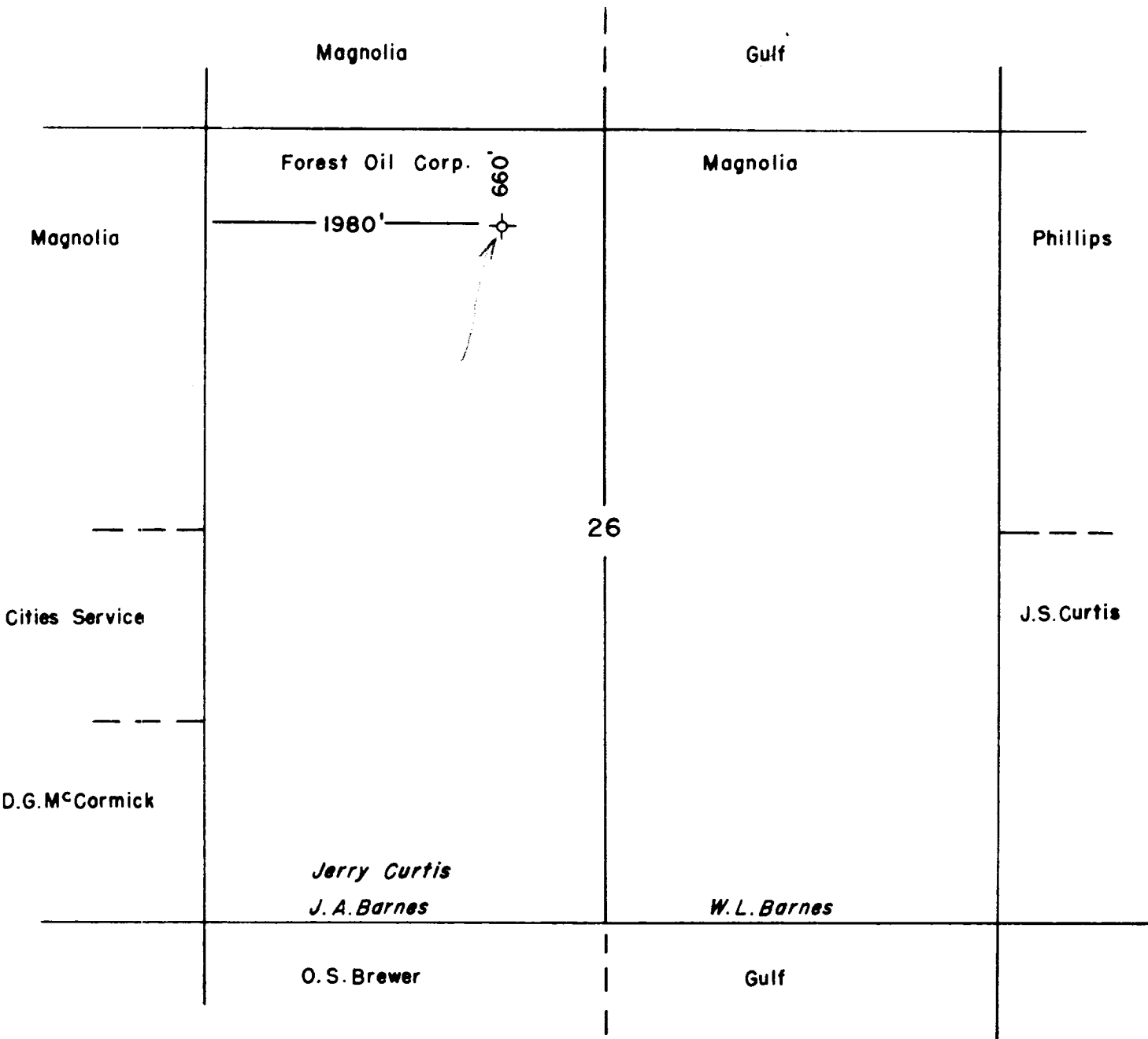
