DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 5505'. Heavy 11 lb. mud pumped into hole from bottom to 1948'. Cemented w/30 Sax from 1948' to 1852', in 8 5/8" Casing. Hole filled to heavy 11 lb. mud. 8 5/8" Csg. shot at 445' and pulled out 445'. Spotted drill pipe at 300' and pumped in 25 Sax. cement. Hole filled w/ heavy 11 lb. mud. Hole bridged at 15' from top and 20' of 4" csg. cemented inside and out to surface of ground, 311' of surface pipe circulated w/235 Sax. to protect surface water. Cellar filled w/ cement. 4" marker set in cement.
