
Dear Mr. Ramey:

After talking with you concerning this well, I reviewed my notes and found that I had been up at this well on March 4, 1962. We dug out the bradenhead and found that one side, between the 8 5/8 and the 4 1/2, was unplugged. My supposition is that somebody removed the valve and the mud finally lightened up and the water started flowing out in a small stream from about 4100 feet down. We put a valve on the opening and stopped the flow. Since we were there four days before the date of your letter from the State Engineer, I believe we have the flow of water stopped.

Mr. Tipps, the foreman on the ranch for Bogle Farms, was present and seemed convinced the difficulty had been overcome. I believe he would have called us again if it hadn't been stopped.
