We request authorization to temporarily abandon this well. Current market conditions render this well uneconomic to produce and further prevent the feasibility of workover operation to return the well to production. We believe the well has production capability in the San Andres zone based on the currently producing well El Zorro C Fed. #2 located one location East, but due to the current low oil prices, predicted to persist until late year 2000, the cost of the workover cannot be justified at this time. The well also has potential for use as a water disposal well.
