## DETAILS OF WORK

The reason for plugging to abandon this newely drilled well, as discussed with Mr. M.H. Soyster, Engineer, is that no evidence of oil was found in the formation to which the well had been projected. Salt water was encountered in the lower part of the well; and the limestone section expected to be productive failed to show any signs of porosity, staining, odor or fluorescense after recovering 100% of the core made through the entire section.

Jet shots were discharged opposite this section and when tested failed to produce the slightest evidence of the presence of oil or gas. Records of the shooting and the drill stem tests made have been filed previously.
