DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pressure tested the 4453 ft. of new 9 5/8" 40# J-55 Pittsburgh Smis casing with 1000 psi before and after drilling the plug. The casing had been cemented with 2200 sax of HOWCO 8% gel cement and 400 sax of neat cement.

The pressure remained constant at 1000 psi and held for the required time of 30 minutes before and after drilling the plug.
