Ran 4453 ft. of 9 5/8" 40# J-55 Ptsbgh Sals casing and cemented at 4466 ft. with 2600 sax cement; HOWCO combination float-shoe on bottom, HOWCO float top of first joint. Five HOWCO centralizers on lower 160 feet of casing. Total depth 4502 ft. HOWCO furnished 2200 sax 8% gel cement and 400 sax of neat cement from shoe upward.

Bore hole was calipered by HOWCO.

Cement circulated to pits long before plug hit float.

Plug down at 2:30 PM December 8, 1951

Plan to test 9 5/8" casing before and after drilling plug early Monday morning, December 10, 1951.

Mr. Lambert with George P. Livermore, Inc., will supervise testing of casing.
