Routine regulation check of surface casing. 13 3/8" 48# H-40 new SMS casing set at 314.5 RDF with 350 sac cement. The cement circulated to the surface, and was allowed to set up for a period of 26 hours.
The casing was tested for 30 Min. with 600# pressure and no pressure loss noted. This work was done under the supervision of Mr. Bill Lambert, Toolpusher.
