Ran 304 jts 7" OD R-80 23 - 26 & 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ casing and set at 9710 DF.
 Cemented 1st stage below DV tool w/ 200 sacks neat at 9 AM 5/15/55. Circulated out above DV Tool 4 hours.
 Cemented 2nd stage w/ 1000 sacks w/ 4% gel. Plug down at 3 PM 5/15/55.
 Temperature survey shows top of cement to be at 5760 RB.

Tested 7" casing below and above DV Tool w/ 1000# pressure for 30 minutes with no decrease in pressure.

Drilled out cement and tested 7" casing for water shut off w/ 1000# pressure for 30 minutes with no decrease in pressure. May 17, 1955.
