## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Allowed cement to set for 47 hours,- then tested the 7" OD 26 and 29 lb. N-80 casing before drilling the plug with 1000 psi mud pressure with no loss in pressure during the 30 minute period. Had used HOWCO Formation Packer Shoe in order to keep pressure and cement off the pay zone. Drilled plug and found 7 ft. of cement above the Formation Packer Shoe and no cement below the packer.

Displaced the drilling mud with water and the water with oil; preparing to try for completion.


