Pressure Tested the 4209.5 ft. of 9 5/8" 40# J-55 Sals Casing with 1000 psi before and after drilling the plug; the casing had been cemented with 2900 sack of BOWCO bulk cement in two stages,-- BOWCO multiple stage cementer.

The casing pressure remained constant with the 1000 psi pressure and held for the required time of 30 minutes.
