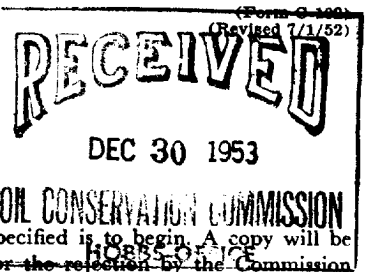

Plan to drill stem test zone 9685 to 9695 to determine productivity and complete well. Drill stem test will be above McCullough bridging plug set at 9900 with cement and sand cap to 9695 which were employed in previous plugging. Will run 5 1/2" combination 17# J-55 and 17# N-80 Liner and cement according to rules and regulations of Commission. Liner will overlap approximately 200' into the 9 5/8" salt string.
