DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5607' of new 5 1/2" OD, 17#, N-80 and J-55 liner was run and hung in 9 5/8" OD pipe with a Brown Type "C" liner hanger 10' long. Top of liner is at 4068, 209' above bottom of 9 5/8" pipe.

200 Sxs. of cement was spotted around bottom of liner at 9685 and after allowing it to set for 36 hrs, a Baker Med "K" retainer was set at 4038 and top of liner squeezed with 350 Sxs. and 1700-2000 psi. After this cement set 60 hrs., and bottom cement approximately 100 hrs; the retainer, top cement, and bottom plug was drilled out and liner tested with 1200 psi both before and after drilling plug.

No pressure loss was noted during these tests.
