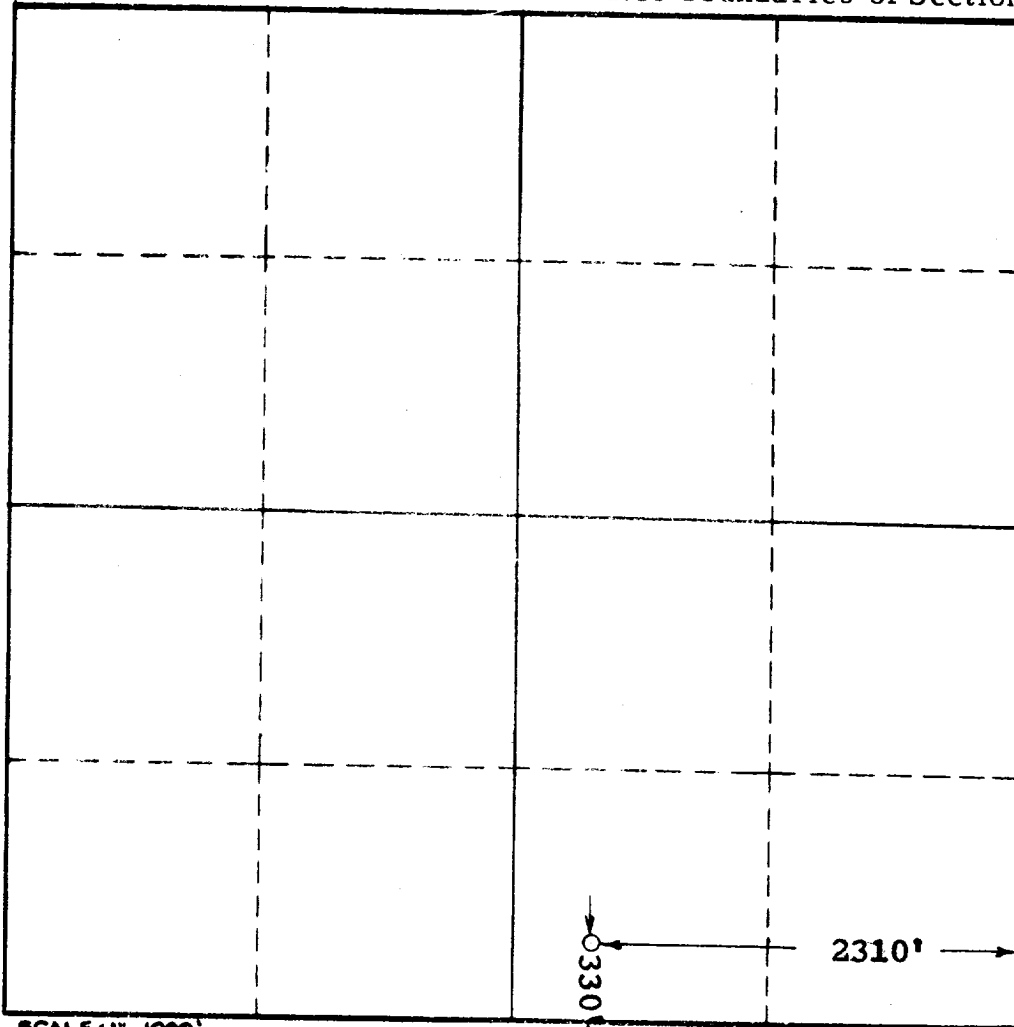



Gentlemen:

Enclosed please find Form C-101 Notice of Intention To Drill in quintuplicate with Form C-128 attached to 3 copies thereof for a well this company proposes to drill 330' from the south line and 2310' from the east line of Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 36 East in the Crossroads Pool of Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be known as Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company Well No. 1-23 located in Unit 0 of this section.

This Santa Fe Pacific Railroad lease lies across the section line with 160 acres in Section 23-9S-36E and 160 acres in Section 26-9S-36E. At the present time there are 2 wells producing from the Devonian formation of the Crossroads Field on the portion of this lease that lies in Section 26. Inasmuch as the royalty owners and leasehold owners are common under this lease, it is our intention to produce this well, SFPRR 1-23, into the tank battery located in Section 26 and now serving SFPRR Wells No. 1-26 and No. 2-26.
