DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The zone from 12,165 to 12,200 was acidised with 750 gals. of 20% acid. A top pressure of 4900 psi was obtained before the formation took acid. The pressure then dropped slowly to 800 psi.

After treatment the well flowed 244 bbls. of oil in 16 hours on 12/64" choke.
