A 17 1/2" hole was drilled to 374' and 382' of new 13 3/8 OD SMLS 40# E-40 casing was set and cemented at 369' (RDP) with 375 Szs of HCNBO cement; the cement being circulated to surface. Plug was down at 12:30 A.M., November 16, 1954.

The pipe will be tested for a period of thirty minutes after allowing cement to set for 24 hours.

This test will be under the supervision of Mr. Ray Allen, Toolpusher for Great Western Drilling Company.
