

TEXAS-GULF STATE LEA WELL #3

LOG TO DEPTH 600  
DATE 4 MAR 1945

DST #1 11835'-11865'

Tool open  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hrs. Two bubbles of air and died. Reopened in 15 minutes, bubbled and died. Recovered 1800' of water blanket and 90' of drilling mud. No shows.

DST #2 11835'-11880'

Tool open 1 hr. with weak blow and died. Reopened after 15 minutes and died. Recovered 1800' of water blanket and 60' of drilling mud. No shows.

DST #3 12020'-12049'

Tool open  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hrs. open 3 minutes, 3 bubbles of air and died. Reopened after 15 minutes with few bubbles and died in 1 minute. Recovered 2000' of water blanket and 30' of drilling mud. No shows of oil, gas, or water.

DST #4 12030'-12087'

Tool open with fair blow throughout. Recovered 2000' of water blanket, 50' of drilling mud and 1000' of salt water. No shows of oil or gas. Recovered 150' of free salt water below circulating swab.
