Set cement plugs as follows: 50 sack plug 12,950-819, top Devonian; 50 sack plug 11,550-419, top Atoka; 50 sack plug 4870-4739, top San Andres; 25 sack plug 4450-4390, bottom 9 5/8" casing; 25 sack plug at surface. Intervals between plugs filled with mud. Installed location marker. Well plugged and Abandoned.

Drilling started 4-26-58, completed 8-11-58, plugging started 8-14-58, completed 8-15-58. Location restored to original condition.
