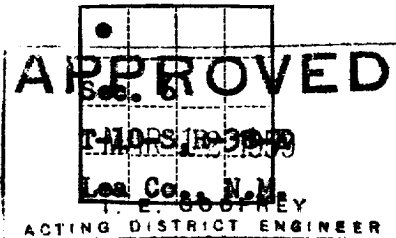

DETAILS OF WORK

Well abandoned due to its not being capable of making oil in commercial quantity. No oil has been produced from this well since September 20, 1958. Duplicate well log has previously been filed with your office.

Will set 15 sack plug across perforations 4900-4997'; will shoot off & pull 5½" casing to approximately 3000'; will set 15 sack plug in & out of the stub of the 5½" casing; 15 sack plug in Rustler approximately 2220'; 15 sack plug in & out of the base of the 8-5/8" casing; 10 sack plug at surface with a 10' long 4" marker extending 4' above ground level, properly marked with the company, well number, name & location. Will use mud of sufficient weight to comply with requirements of United States Geological Survey & New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
