FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The State BE, currently shut-in, has been pumping approximately 100% water. Well earnings are such that it is uneconomical to operate this well and no remedial work is feasible in the Devonian.

It is proposed that the present Devonian perforations be squeezed off and the Wolfcamp zone perforated from 9446 to 9462⁴. It is further recommended that the new zone, Wolfcamp, receive acid treatment. It is expected that a top allowable flowing well will result from the workover.
