Dear Mr. Trobaugh:

This is with reference to your letter of September 16, 1966 concerning the mix-up on allowable assignment for your Dallas No. 2 located in Unit L of Section 15, T-11-S, R-33-E.

After discussing this situation with my staff I find that you had submitted Forms C-103, C-104, C-105 and C-126 which were brought into this office on Friday, September 2, 1966. You later submitted Form C-103 and Form C-104 which showed an increase in potential for the well and which we assumed was a corrected Form C-104. We therefore discarded the original Form C-104 and processed the later C-104 as the initial allowable request.

As to the records in your office reflecting that Mr. B. H. Norris hand delivered these forms on August 30th, this is not accurate. Mr. Norris personally handed these forms to me on Friday, September 2nd and requested that they be processed as soon as possible since he knew our office would be closed on the following Monday. I asked him if the forms were all in order and he stated that they were. However, when I started to process the forms that afternoon it was noted that there was only one copy of the deviation survey which had not been notarized.

In view of the situation, you definitely are not eligible to receive any August allowable for this well.
