Dear Mr. Houston:

As per our previous discussions, Sun has determined that the 257 barrels of oil recovered from the captioned well when casing therein was pulled after termination of our lease is in fact the property of Mrs. Sawyer. I have been informed that these 257 barrels have remained in storage on the lease during this controversy. Our only remaining problem pertains to the disposition of this oil. Does Mrs. Sawyer have the means available by which to take possession of this oil and sell same? Or is it your wish that Sun sell the oil for your client? In the latter event we would have to charge your client a reasonable fee for disposing of it on her behalf as well as her proportionate share of windfall profits, severance taxes, etc. Please advise as soon as possible as to how your client wishes to proceed.
