APPLICATION OF COASTAL OIL AND GAS CORPORATION FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Coastal Oil and Gas Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on September 18, 1992, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its P. Marr Well No. 1-33 located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 33, Township 9 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant herein, Coastal Oil and Gas Corporation is hereby authorized to complete its P. Marr Well No. 1-33 located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 33, Township 9 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 4985 feet to 5050 through 2 3/8-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 4935 feet.
