Casing was cemented in accordance with NMOC Option 2 as follows:

1. Volume of slurry - 383 ft³ - Southwestern, API Class H w/2% CaCl₂
2. Approximate temperature of slurry - 65° F.
3. Estimated minimum formation temperature - 92° F.
4. Estimated cement strength at time of testing - 1310 psi.
5. Actual time cement in place prior to starting test - 12 hours
